


Engineering Updates

As always, TEMO is looking at updating design and engineering to make the installation process easier, more versatile and TEMO STRONG! Pictured to the right are updated designs to be aware of. First, is our new 4x4 extruded aluminum insert for freestanding installation. It will replace the previously used steel insert. Additionally, the the New Roma post can be used independently for the same purpose.

Next, we are using these same posts to accommodate freestanding structures on decks by going through the decking and attaching to the deck posts. This will allow you to overcome the ongoing challenges of building freestanding pergolas on decks and bypass the need to get permits in many of the municipalities that allow for this.

Finally, we have put a new method together to assemble the Florentine Column. Many have used a rubber mallet to assemble them in the past. This method works but has a higher risk of damage. TEMO is now recommending to interlock one side first and then use the pictured clamps to interlock the other. This will insure a proper connection and limit potential damage to the post by using unneeded force to assemble the post.
